Introduction

Nature Appreciation Report

This report is designed to help you learn more about your own, inner nature; to appreciate nature around you; and to know what you can do to protect the environment in the best way possible, given your uniqueness as an individual.

In this report, your planets in the signs indicate your inner nature and the natural species and phenomena with which you, as an individual, have an affinity. Your planets in the houses indicate the activities which you would enjoy, pertaining to nature. Your planetary aspects indicate the environmental causes where you would have a particular talent, and where you could express yourself in a positive way towards helping to preserve nature.

Chapter 1: The Sun

Sun in Scorpio:

As Scorpio is ruled by the outermost planet, Pluto, you are able to deal constructively with extremes which would scare other people off. You are able to find creative uses for that which others have discarded and, in general, to transform and regenerate. Everything in nature goes around in a circle, rather than just living once and that being the end of it. For example, fields, if left unattended, will eventually have bushes grow in them and then taller trees, until there is a forest. However, the forest is not the very last stage, because eventually the tall trees will prevent new trees from growing by blocking out the sun, and when the tall trees die, the whole process of natural successions will start all over again., until a new forest grows up. In order for the tall trees to decay when they die and turn into usable soil, there have to be small organisms to break them down, and they would be ruled by Scorpio. Eaters of carrion such as vultures would also be ruled by Scorpio, because they help convert what was a waste product into usable material again. On the human level, Scorpios help humanity to deal with death and destruction in such a way that life can go on, rather than just end there.

Sun in the 4th House

You have a strong interest in maintaining a nurturing home for your family, and you would also be good at preserving local history and heritage trails. You have a special talent for sensitive caring, and you would be able to care for young animals and birds, with remarkable success in encouraging them to recover. That is because you would be aware of their moods and food needs. You are tuned in to nature's cycles, and you may be interested in gardening according to the phases of the moon. You would enjoy quiet, peaceful recreation with your family, such as camping or sailing.

Sun Sextile Jupiter:

You have good opportunities to gain recognition for publishing articles or books about nature and the outdoors, especially for children. Do not take these

opportunities for granted because this work is genuinely needed, and you would find great fulfillment and happiness in doing it. You have an unusual talent for creatively bringing outdoor, wilderness activities out into the limelight, so that people can relate to nature and value it, by identifying with it. You may find that television or films are a useful way of doing this; or perhaps you could lead expeditions in person yourself.

Sun Square Uranus:

You have the willpower to struggle with new inventions until you succeed. For example, you could work on new ideas and applications regarding solar energy. You could do original work with astrology and nature and get recognized for it. You are able to bring in a new, intuitive dimensions towards solving earthly problems, especially if you meditate on how the sun is the source of life on earth and how this life is part of a more far-reaching purpose, to which we can re-connect for the future.

Sun Conjunct Neptune:

You have good creative ability with nature photography or art, and you could work to show people what nature is like and encourage their empathy for it. As long as you are also grounded in everyday reality, you could be a channel of divine inspiration about nature and how to care for it, and how people are part of it. You could lead others in protecting fish from chemicals in the water. You have great sensitivity to nature's creatures and their young, and you would be good at encouraging children to have the same, caring attitude.

Sun Sextile Pluto:

You could unfold your vast creative potential by getting involved in projects which would save the planet from ultimate destruction, such as atomic energy, repair of the ozone layer, or recycling of waste materials. You have a very valuable and rare contribution to make in these areas, because you are able to deal with extremes while still being constructive. Your leadership ability, even in times of disaster, would inspire many to overcome and rebuild.

Chapter 2: The Moon

Moon in Aries:

Your emotional nature is impulsive and likely to flare up with anger, but you are just as quick to forgive and make a new start. You were likely born on a day when the weather suddenly became warm. You may be dominating on the domestic scene, because you really need a home for yourself, where you can be independent and do things in your own way.

Moon in the 10th House

You would feel at home defending the environment in a political position and getting the public to care about conservation. You would be good at providing for the practical needs of small creatures, and you might be interested in vermiculture, such as how worms re-condition the soil and keep it fertile.

Moon Opposition Mars:

If you work at nurturing yourself and finding constructive outlets for your physical energy, you will come to have an unusual empathy for animals, because they also need good care and exercise. You would probably enjoy having a dog as a pet, because it would be a good companion for you, and you would get exercise taking it out for regular walks.

Moon Trine Uranus:

Your early home life was unusual in a positive way, and you had unique

opportunities to learn how to nurture the plants and animals. You would have a natural ability to use astrology to understand more about this. Your psychic receptivity would enable you to pick up on the subtle messages from nature's creatures and to teach others more about being tuned in. You would do well to develop these very valuable talents.

Chapter 3: Mercury

Mercury in Libra:

You are very concerned about how people communicate in relationships, and the psychological benefits of harmonious partnerships. In the animal world, the communication between dogs and their owners would be an example of Mercury in Libra energy. A dog can show great loyalty to a human, and learn to obey verbal commands in order to please the master.

The movement of a pair of swallows flying through the air is another example of the agility of Mercury combined with the gracefulness of Libra. The swallows will glide towards each other until they almost touch, all the while calling to each other to communicate their location, and then they will veer off in opposite directions, still maintaining the symmetrical pattern with each other's flight.

Mercury in the 4th House

You would have a good knowledge of local history and ecology, and you might have others coming to your home to share information about these subjects. You would be able to teach them how to grow plants and care for birds and animals. You might like to take your children out camping or sailing or on nature walks. You would have good ability as a nurse or helping with veterinary care.

Chapter 4: Venus

Venus in Scorpio:

Once a relationship has been severed, you will never let it start up again, because you will not let the other person affect your deep, sensitive emotions again. However, in a love relationship, you will sacrifice anything for your beloved.

An example of Venus in Scorpio principle in nature is the love-life of spiders, because, in some species, after they mate, the female will kill the male and eat him.

Venus in the 5th House

You love children and could get them involved in gardening in such a way as to make it fun for them. You are very artistic, and might be able to paint beautiful, colorful nature scenes which would point out to people how nice nature is. You might be able to get children interested in berry-picking, looking after farm animals, or observing the details of plants and trees, so as to be able to draw them.

Venus Conjoint Saturn:

You would also be interested in preserving farmland and stopping the erosion of soil. You would see the value of planting trees in this, and the trees would also serve to block the wind. Chapter 5: Mars

Mars in Libra:

When the females arrive in a later flock, the males display the red on their wings to attract a female. Mars in the 4th House

You would be good at improving your own and other people's homes to make them more environmentally friendly. You might enjoy outings with your family to go camping, canoeing, sailing, or kayaking. You would work hard to preserve local history, heritage trails, and natural habitat. Chapter 6: Jupiter

Jupiter in Leo:

Jupiter in the 2nd House

Because you have business ability for acquiring property, you could obtain land and preserve it as wildlife habitat. You could succeed in an eco-tourist business in which you could teach visitors from faraway places about the value of the earth and the life it supports.

Jupiter Sextile Neptune:

Jupiter Conjunct Pluto:

Chapter 7: Saturn

Chapter 8: Uranus

Chapter 9: Neptune

Neptune in Libra:

Chapter 10: Pluto

Pluto in Leo:
