INTRODUCTION: NATAL CHART

Astrology/astronomy is the oldest recorded science known to man. Much precious space has been given to recording the appearance, disappearance, and cyclical movements of the Sun, Moon, planets and stars in early man's tedious efforts to communicate his history AND his ideas to future generations. Sumerian cuneiform script on clay tablets dating back over 2,000 years BC had texts correlating time (calendars) to the heavenly bodies. Many tablets also displayed some of the same glyphs and characters that we use today in astrology, while others recorded the close correlation observed between earthly and celestial phenomena.

In the seventh century BC, Assyrian Astrologers became quite sophisticated in predicting eclipses and retrogradation of the planets by observing their movements against the background of the stars and constellations. These observations provided the earliest body of knowledge on which the study of both Astrology and Astronomy are based today. However, this was not the purpose of their observations. The astrologer's responsibilities were to provide their priests and rulers with favorable and unfavorable times for religious and social activities, and for the affairs of state. As a result of their efforts, a considerable body of knowledge and astrological lore was accumulated and recorded.

Early man gazed at the planets and stars and discovered that their positions in the heavens and their distances from each other were constantly changing, and that those changes formed patterns which were repeated and predictable. He observed that all of nature in his world was directly related to those changes. Confined as he was to a small patch of earth where even boundaries and limits were unknown, it is little wonder that he began to correlate the events in his own life with the cycles of the planets and the stars, and to seek to live in harmony with their changing patterns and with nature.

Today's man, through the science of Astronomy, uses these same stars to guide him on his personal visits to some of these heavenly bodies. Astronomy also helps modern man to place his own stars (satellites) in the sky. Some of these provide forms of communication which would be as difficult for early man

to believe and understand as it seems to be for some Astronomers and others to believe that the ORIGINAL planets can still communicate influences to man today. Since these influences affect only the feelings, and the individual does have free will to make his own decisions, Astrology cannot meet a "scientific test" of "repeated results under controlled conditions". Neither can religion, for that matter, yet most people believe in some form of religion.

Astrologers have been observing correlations of "As Above, So Below" for centuries, resulting in a tremendous body of knowledge. They are constantly studying, comparing, defining, delineating, and recording these influences and their meanings. Today, sophisticated computers make these tasks easier and the information more reliable. Thanks to the diligence of the ancients for preserving the records and to the enormous capacity of computers to store and sort information, today's Astrologer can cast a better chart and interpret it more accurately and completely than ever before.

The Natal Chart interpretations are found by computing the astrological data for the date, time, and place of your birth. Your chart is unique in its combination of planetary positions, aspects, and influences. There are literally thousands of variables in the natal chart alone, and each individual will usually have less than a hundred of these variables in his or her chart. We will print all of those which apply to your particular birth time and place, and they are what make you the unique individual that you are. We try to present this information in such a way that you can recognize and interpret the "blueprint" of your own "Personality Profile."

There will be Delineations that appear to absolutely contradict each other, and there will be some that you cannot believe applies to you at all. Please try to keep an open mind and read the Natal Report all the way through. We will address all these concerns, and more, on the last page.

Astrology is not "fatalism". "What Is To Be" is not necessarily what WILL be. The individual always has free will to make his/her own choices. Your horoscope reveals the astrological imprints upon your personality at the time of your birth. It has been up to you to decide which influences to accept and which influences to challenge. Personal growth results from those choices. Read the interpretation of your Natal chart and look back on your life. Is this you? Was this you? We think you will be amazed!

YOUR ASTROLOGICAL IDENTITY

The sign which the Sun was in when you were born tends to give you your astrological identity. How many times have you heard the question, "What sign are you"? . . . How many times have you had people identify themselves with the statement: "I am a Leo, I am an Aries, I am a Pisces", etc. . . . Many times for both questions, I am sure.

Practically everyone knows his or her own Sun-sign. You probably have also noticed that most people have heard some simplistic Sun-sign interpretations and they are likely to add, "I am a natural leader--I'm a Leo, you know"; or, "Of course I have a temper, I'm an Aries"; or, "Pisces people are naturally psychic".

These generalities are sometimes accurate, but not all Leos are leaders, not all Arians have temper tantrums, nor, are all Pisceans especially psychic. Even when these simplistic statements are true, there are many more influences in the Sun-sign of each individual and many other astrological influences that affect that individual's personality. If astrology were taken no farther than the Sun-sign, it would be telling us that we are like every other person who was born under our particular Sun-sign!

The Sun sign IS perhaps the most important SINGLE factor among the thousands of variables drawn from when setting up the horoscope. Through the sign it occupies at the time of your birth, it colors your personality so strongly that it usually can be recognized throughout your lifetime. It indicates the ways in which you express your basic energy potential and your creative drive to grow and develop as an individual. It is also one of the major factors from which you draw upon to develop your personal identity and self worth.

You have only one Sun-sign, however, and even if it IS the most powerful of all the stellar bodies, its influences are modified by the house in which it is found and by its hemispheric location in the chart. Its relationship to the Natal Moon is also legendary, and warrants special attention in the interpretation process. Even more modifications can be expected from the aspects of the Sun to the other planets and to the Ascendant and Midheaven, from what "Mode" and

"Element" it is in, and by the house positions of the sign Leo, which is "ruled" by the Sun. When you take all these things into consideration you can certainly see that there is much, much more to your identity than your Sun-sign.

However, this popular interest in Sun-sign astrology does account for a proliferation of Sun-sign publications, and one can find Sun-sign interpretations and legends in literally hundreds of astrological books and magazines today.

In the following delineation of the Sun-sign in your chart, we have tried to include those influences that are most consistent in the interpretations of the ancients, the masters of astrology, and the teachers of astrology--as well as those of the many gifted researchers and newcomers in astrology today.

SUN IN CAPRICORN

The Sun is in Capricorn from approximately December 22 through January I9. Key words are ambition, conservatism, conscientiousness, and organization: Key phrase is, "I use". The planet Saturn rules Capricorn, influencing much discipline upon its natives.

In about 1908, Llewellyn George wrote: "In Capricorn the Sun gives a quiet, thoughtful, serious nature, deep mind and good reasoning ability; generally practical, economical and given to investigation. Capricornians act with dignity and self-esteem, are somewhat particular, ambitious and persevering; never entirely discouraged although often disappointed: thorough and hard workers. Careful, cautious, frugal, and make the most of opportunities. Usually meet with some heavy obstacles in the part of desires and progress, yet by dint of persistent, patient and concentrated effort often butt their way through and triumph over circumstances." ("A to Z Horoscope Maker", thirty-sixth printing, Llewellyn Publications, 1974.)

Max Heindel in his book, "The Message to the Stars" (Rosicrucians, 1927), has the following to say: "This is a good sign that the person will rise in life by the aid of the good-will of people in a higher position than himself; it shows that he will merit their trust and acquit himself well in a position of responsibility and trust; it makes him careful, prudent, faithful and honest. Judges with that position cannot be bought but will administer justice as they see it, to all comers. It gives an all-round love of fair play and wins for those who have it the

respect and esteem of all in their circle."

Serious, disciplined, and deeply ambitious from your Sun in Capricorn, you are driven to prove yourself and to achieve material success and recognition. Your work, your position in the world, and your contributions to society are very important to you. You will persevere through many hardships and frustrations in order to achieve what you have set out to do, and you will sacrifice much in the way of home life and personal relationships in order to do so.

You are basically a realist, and though you may have all sorts of colorful theories and dreams, you feel that the ultimate test of anything is its practical usefulness. You have good business sense, but there is a bit of the cynic in you as well. You are clear-headed, detached and objective, and you are not always swayed by emotions. You can be extremely authoritarian: strictly fair, but somewhat without mercy. You have a great respect for tradition and even if you do not agree with certain laws, you will abide by them or work to change them rather than disobey them. Careful and conservative, you always try to play by the rules.

Keeping body and soul together is never enough for you--you have a persistent feeling that you must amount to something. You need some accomplishment to point to, some property to look after, or some obligation to fulfill: it could be in business, politics, or the social or intellectual fields.

Like the symbol of your sign, the mountain goat, you are steady and surefooted. You are not stopped by obstacles that stand in the way of your climb to the top. You believe that success is material security, and that it only comes from hard work (for which you have a great capacity) and you expect something in return for what you contribute.

You ask mercy from no one and you have confidence in your own powers. You are good at finding solutions to the most difficult problems, and are probably an excellent troubleshooter. You want your household managed with precision and everything in working order. You are executive material and remain in a subordinate role for a short time only. You never step backward. You move up by alternating security and ambition as your goals.

You want everything to be sensible. Yet, you have excellent intuitions and you use them in your struggle to achieve personal independence and economic security. You gain knowledge of practical affairs through reading and talking to

people, and you utilize everything you see, hear, and learn.

You can be lonely at times, and very melancholy. You are subtle, understated, quiet, deep, and not easy to know intimately. But you are never superficial. You are a modest person and sometimes overly self-critical. Giving yourself (and others) permission to feel, to play, to be spontaneous and silly, and to be weak and vulnerable sometimes, isn't easy for you.

Fear of being dependent on someone else when you are old enhances your desire for money and security, possibly to the point of being stingy and greedy. Let's just say you tend to be very frugal. You may seem to behave on the principle of "every man for himself", but you have a sensitive personality and want very much to be appreciated.

You need to learn to accept the imperfections of others, to walk more slowly, lighten up, look at the trees, listen to the birds, and smell the roses. Unless you really ARE the legendary god, "Atlas", you don't have to carry the world and everything in it upon your shoulders.

THE PLANETS: POSITIONS AND ASPECTS

Astrology recognizes ten major "heavenly bodies" in the Universe that radiate various influences toward earth, and thus manifest themselves in the lives and affairs of mankind. The Sun and the Moon influences are most recognizable because some of them are visible and tactile, such as light and heat. They also provide the base for mankind's calculation of time--the calendar and the clock. Influences distributed by the other eight planets may be less visible and more subtle, but not less real.

These emanations are constant, but the intensity of their influences can be tempered by the sign they are in, the house of your chart in which they are located, and by their angular aspects to each other. We touched upon this in the introduction to the Ascendant when we also introduced the term "synchronicity". In the following pages we will print the individual interpretations of each planet in your chart with respect to the sign it is in, and its house position.

Following that we will print the interpretation of the planetary aspects to each other. Aspects are specific angles between two or more planets that have been found to modify the influences bestowed. Technically, every angle between planets creates an aspect, but some angles are more significant than others.

Astrology divides these aspects into "Major" and "Minor" categories. Minor aspects are used primarily in astrological research and for very precisely directed work, so we stick to the Major aspects in our general work. The major aspects are: Conjunction (same degree), Sextile (60 degrees), Square (90 degrees), Trine (120 degrees), and Opposition (180 degrees). Don't worry that some of these individual interpretations may seem to conflict with others. We look at the whole person, and the separate parts can modify, reinforce, or nullify each other.

We have pulled all this data together for you as it is displayed in your birth chart. This whole configuration can not be repeated or duplicated during your lifetime. Although the earth in its rotation around the Sun each year goes through all the twelve sign constellations and returns the Sun to its natal position, it takes Neptune 165 years and Pluto 248 years to complete their orbits. The planets are constantly moving their positions throughout the universe so that it is not possible for all the planetary positions and aspects to repeat themselves in your lifetime.

That leaves it up to us as individuals to deal with those influences imprinted upon us at birth and revealed through the horoscope. It is our hope, through astrology, that we may explain what those influences are and thus understand ourselves better. We have free will to make choices--choices which can affect those birth imprints in positive or negative ways. Probably no one of us will ever fulfill the "promises" of the natal chart in our lifetime, but hopefully, knowing what the influences are could help us to make some better choices.

PLANETARY SIGN:

The following planetary sign and house positions are determined by YOUR

birth data. There are 384 variations of these positions, as well as many other variables, but only 25 of them apply to each individual. The possibility of another person having the same combination of positions is practically non-existent.

The Sun and the Moon are known as the "Lights" and are not planets in the technical sense of the word. However, they are the most visible and perhaps more influential in affecting man's awareness than all of the other heavenly bodies put together. The blend of the Sun-Moon influences, from the signs they are in, and whether they are in aspect or not, are extremely significant to the personality profile of the new life. The relationship of the Sun and Moon to each other by their position, sign, and aspect and their relationship to the Ascendant can sometimes provide us with an extremely accurate mini-interpretation of the chart. The interpretation of your Sun-Moon combination is printed next. Study it carefully--as well as the next three Sun and Moon sign delineations.

CAPRICORN SUN AND VIRGO MOON--These are two Earth signs trine to each other. Capricorn is in the Cardinal mode, Virgo in Mutable. There can be a certain timidity in the personality hidden behind a tendency to over-emphasize the importance of organization and detail. The nervous system is highly charged, and work can become a way of bolstering self-worth. The key here is perspective and goal-oriented discipline. You have a very good head for business and will be successful if you can get beyond the picky details and learn to delegate. You are very stable, extremely reliable, and are dependable with family affairs and relationships. You need to lighten up and develop a sense of humor. Take time out to "smell the roses".

MOON IN VIRGO--In mythology the Moon is always female--as the Sun is always male. In most ancient religions and cults, the Moon represents the female force which reflects the male force of the Sun. In astrology, "she" bestows her indiscriminative influences upon both male and female alike, though each sex might respond to the influences in different ways. The Moon in the signs indicates the emotional responses to life's situations. It determines how you are likely to react to external influences and to the actions of others.

In Virgo it indicates an exacting, hardworking, practical nature. You are particular about food and diet, and concerned about health. You have a great regard for neatness and cleanliness in personal hygiene and housekeeping as well.

This sign can even impose upon the emotional moon-child logical and orderly ways of doing things. You are likely to understand even technical applications for doing things, but there will always be the caring and longings to help others. You are more likely to express your love by doing things for people rather than by saying it in words. Intimate relationships may prove difficult and hard to come by for your expectations will be pretty high, and it is difficult for you to express your feelings. Relationships are important for your feelings of well-being, and losing one can cause painful depression.

Although ambition may not be extremely high, you can do about anything you would choose to do in the way of profession or vocation. Your technical skills are easily developed, and the caring disposition for others could open doors in the people-helping-people professions. Your skills will always be supplemented and influenced by emotional undertones.

You may appear shy, for you are likely to like to work behind the scenes. You pay attention to details and have a sincere desire to serve. You could risk being blinded to the overall picture by your obsession with details, so you need to look beyond the present picky activities and avoid excessive preoccupation with them. Watch out for a critical attitude of others whose style of doing things may differ from your own.

MERCURY IN CAPRICORN--Mercury in the signs gives clues to the kinds of concerns that occupy your mind, and reveals your intellectual and psychological approach to making decisions and conveying your ideas to others. In Capricorn it indicates an interest in literature, science, chemistry, philosophy, and the occult. You can be careful and painstaking toward developing your intellect. You are likely to become acute, sharp, penetrating, tactful, curious, diplomatic, and critical. You need to watch out for peevishness, fickleness, restlessness, discontent, and unreasonable suspicions.

VENUS IN AQUARIUS--Venus in the signs indicates how you express your emotions in personal relationships, and your attitudes toward money, personal possessions, creature comforts, and social and aesthetic values. In Aquarius, it indicates an impersonal but friendly emotional outlook--you want to be

friendly with everyone, but not necessarily on a personal level. Yet, you are likely to be popular and to have many friends. You have an unusually sparkling, effervescent quality in your personal manner. Intellectual stimulation is important in romance and marriage, and you may be attracted to ingenious or eccentric types. Romantic attractions are often sudden and casual, not necessarily stable and lasting. You like money, but like more what it will buy. You may be attracted to art forms that are extremely modern or extremely ancient. You are likely to have a special attraction for electronic art forms, or for art appreciation through electronic media. Beware of the potential to sudden and radical changes in your emotional outlook. You may have a hidden desire for greater emotional freedom for yourself, but harbor stubborn attitudes toward emotional freedom for others.

MARS IN ARIES--Mars, the planet of energy, gives us information about modes of action as a result of the desire principle. It influences ambition and indicates some forms of expressing our emotional behavior. In Aries it bestows force, self-assurance, originality, combativeness, and mechanical ability. You are enthusiastic and inspiring, philosophic and idealistic in spirit, and very frank and open. You like sports, pleasure and adventure. You will have a strong self-interest and will push on toward your goals and ambitions with very little outside encouragement. You dislike limitations and restraints, and will more than likely be your own boss in your profession or vocation. You need to watch out for overwork and burnout--also for a hasty temper.

JUPITER IN GEMINI--Jupiter in the signs indicates your ethical, religious, and philosophical standards and beliefs, and how you may express these interests. In Gemini, it gives a friendly disposition; courteous, truthful and trustworthy. You are able to express sympathy, charity, and benevolence. You have an intellectual curiosity that leads to mental development. You are able to express new ideas in fields related to travel, writing, and study. You will be attracted to the history of religion, education, law, and philosophy. You will have tendencies toward mental restlessness and "dabbling" in many areas of study and interests, so you need to ground your knowledge in practical experience in order to avoid going off on tangents.

SATURN IN TAURUS--Saturn in the signs indicates the areas in which you must accept responsibility and the ways in which you must practice discipline and develop maturity. When found in Taurus, you will need discipline and hard work to acquire material possessions. You will have a strong need for financial and emotional security. You are thoughtful, kind, and quiet, but, sometimes

quick-tempered, resentful, and stubborn. You are frugal and may manage business affairs well. Watch out for tendencies to miserliness and excessive materialism.

URANUS IN TAURUS--Uranus in the signs indicates the ways in which you manifest your urge for freedom and individuality: also the motivations behind your wishes, hopes, and goals of the mind. In Taurus, the subject is usually money and ideas of how to get it and use it. You are likely to seek reforms in business and the economy in practical but unique ways. You can be very determined, and are likely to buck the conservative institutions in business and government that reflect only materialism. You will not want to let excessive materialism dampen your spiritual impulses or the expression of intuitive ideas.

NEPTUNE IN VIRGO--Neptune in the signs manifests more historical and generational influences than personal. It indicates the kind of cultural expression shown by the imaginative and creative faculties of mankind over a given period of time. In your personal responses to Neptune in Virgo, you could show a tendency toward psychosomatic illnesses. You also could exhibit excessive emotional preoccupation with inconsequential detail. You may feel doubt or negativity toward your intuitive impulses, wanting to prove them in materialistic ways with hard, "scientific" evidence.

PLUTO IN LEO--Pluto in the signs is also historical and generational, but on a personal level it indicates permanent change. In Leo it will make those changes in the areas of leadership, indicating that you could be a leader in your field, and, though the struggle may be great, the achievement could be sudden. But when it comes, it is likely to be permanent.

PLANETARY ASPECTS:

Following are the interpretations of the planetary aspects to each other. Aspects are angular relationships between two or more planets that have been found to modify the influences bestowed. Significant angles are: Conjunction (same degree), Sextile (60 degrees), Square (90 degrees), Trine (120 degrees), and Opposition (180 degrees). Don't worry that some of these individual interpretations seem to conflict. Remember--we look at the whole

person, and the separate parts can modify, reinforce, or nullify each other.

SUN TRINE SATURN--This aspect bestows good organizational ability and powers of concentration. You are likely to have a conservative disposition, honest and practical. You don't like to waste resources or efforts, and will exercise discipline to reach your objectives. You are very patient and do not like to take chances.

SUN TRINE THE NORTH NODE--This aspect confers leadership ability and indicates public favor and popularity. It offers the ability to exercise your will and express yourself in harmony with the prevailing social attitudes and institutions.

MOON CONJUNCT NEPTUNE--This aspect bestows a vivid imagination and inspiration to music and the arts. You are very much in tune to the vibrations around you and to what others are thinking. This intuition can cause you to be too easily influenced if you are not constantly aware. This sign almost provides an open door to the psychic world, but you need to be cautious about occult experiences. Fantasies and the wrong kind of influences are also free to come and go through that door. Spiritual guidance is indicated here.

MOON TRINE MERCURY--This trine between the planet of emotions and the planet of intellect can give you a good memory and a good working relationship between your conscious and your unconscious mind. You are likely to be a good conversationalist because you are truly interested in whomever you are communicating with. You can emotionally and logically understand and communicate the ordinary, daily life affairs, and you probably have a good business sense. This is a rare supportive aspect.

MOON TRINE SATURN--This trine indicates honesty and common sense and is likely to make you cautious and conservative. It can give you organizational ability and the perseverance to achieve long range goals. You are likely to be shrewd and perceptive in business, and to practice self-discipline in your business affairs. You have great personal dignity and a sense of responsibility in carrying out your obligations.

MOON TRINE URANUS--This trine provides you with a sparkling personality. You will have much energy and determination, with a lively imagination. There could be great business ability, especially concerning things new and innovative. You are likely to seek unusual experiences and excitement as

opposed to a conventional existence. Psychic abilities are indicated, with interests in the occult sciences--including Astrology.

MERCURY OPPOSITE PLUTO--This aspect can put you in a position in which you must deal with secret, or (possibly) dangerous information. At any rate, you are likely to be the repository of much confidential information, and well able to keep it so--since secretiveness is a part of your nature. You need to watch out for an unusual curiosity about others, and avoid your tendency to interrogate them. You would make an excellent detective, but you could risk resentment and bad personal relationships by excessive nosiness. Your secretiveness about your psychic interests could be detrimental to spiritual development. You need to trust more in the positive spiritual forces in your life.

MERCURY SQUARE MARS--This square produces an active, energetic mind, but you may have tendencies to become overeager to the point of impatience and argumentativeness. You may jump to conclusions before considering all the facts and viewpoints. Your reasoning is often interfered with by your emotions, especially anger. Remember, square aspects create stresses and set up tensions. You should strive for more patience, exercise diplomacy, and learn to be a good listener in order to overcome the negatives in this aspect. The lesson to be learned here is ego detachment.

MERCURY TRINE SATURN--This trine helps you with mental organization, especially in performing systematic mental work where there is little room for error. It should help you as a student because of the capacity for patience and hard work. It is a good aspect for writers and teachers because of the ability to pay attention to details. You are likely to be serious minded in general and disciplined in your thinking. You need to watch for tendencies toward taking yourself too seriously, and allow for some fun thinking along the way.

MERCURY TRINE URANUS--This trine confers a special mental ability that is linked to the intuitive faculties. You are likely to have a humanitarian outlook. You could be attracted to scientific and occult areas of study, well suited for investigation and research into new areas of thought, and have a natural understanding of subtle energy sources. This is a good aspect for Astrologers, for it provides scientific understanding of occult principles. You are not likely to be bound by tradition, but arrive at your own conclusions independent of popularly held views. You are able to express your thoughts originally and dramatically, and have an excellent memory. You are able to understand and use artificial electronic intelligence--especially computers--along with

specialized skills which are important to your career.

MERCURY TRINE NEPTUNE--This trine gives an intuitive mind with the ability to read the thoughts of others. You could also be prophetic. You are able to mentally visualize objects and processes in complete detail. This trine is likely to bestow musical ability, especially in the area of composition and understanding the composer's meaning. Your senses are liable to be extremely delicate and acute, causing you to avoid loud noises and harsh conditions. You have a vivid imagination, and are likely to be able to visualize psychic premonitions--also likely to understand them. This gift should be cultivated through positive spiritual exploration and growth.

VENUS SQUARE SATURN--This square brings tensions into play in the social and artistic expression. Saturn, the disciplinarian, limits fun and games, so this is a teaching kind of aspect. It can make us work for our leisure, as well as the other good things of life. The lesson is discipline, and the key is to make it positive. There can be emotional setbacks and unfulfilled romances, and we need to be aware that "these too shall pass". People with this aspect should avoid escapism in any form. Many alcoholics and drug addicts have Venus square Saturn in their charts.

VENUS SQUARE URANUS--This is the aspect of sudden infatuations--with people, places, and things. Infatuations that are likely to be short-lived, but exiting while they last. This square can make it difficult for you to know the difference between love and friendship, and a tendency to seek emotional gratification could cause recurring, as well as long term, difficulties. You will not want to sacrifice personal freedom for long-term emotional commitments, and it could be easy to confuse sex with love--and vice versa. You need to moderate your desires for exotic, exhilarating emotional experiences by finding positive, constructive outlets for them.

MARS SQUARE PLUTO--Your willpower is highly developed but may lack direction. You will have a tendency to use force to gain your objectives. You find conflicts between your will and your desires from your spiritual aspirations. You need to learn to practice careful planning and to cultivate diplomacy and love. This is a very powerful aspect and when combined with reason, discipline, and diplomacy, it can provide the energy for great achievements.

JUPITER SQUARE NODE--This aspect can cause conflict and difficulty in adjusting to social institutions. Your religious, educational, and social attitudes

are not likely to be in harmony with the trends and the culture in which you find yourself.

SATURN CONJUNCT URANUS--This aspect creates a good balance between the impulsiveness of Uranus and the controlled discipline of Saturn. It bestows a gift for practical expression of original ideas which are intuitive in form. It can aid in the success of all endeavors requiring a combination of inspiration and practical application. The conjunction can be supportive in applying discipline to the spiritual yearnings, and order to educational and professional efforts.

SATURN TRINE THE NORTH NODE--This configuration can make you appear to be a little old-fashioned, since you are likely to be careful and conservative in social, moral, and business behavior. It is good for working in established institutions and for gaining support from conservative members of society.

URANUS TRINE NEPTUNE--This trine indicates a very high development of spiritual faculties. It is an aspect of long duration and affects a whole generation of people, but pin-points in your own horoscope a decided leaning toward the mystical and the occult. It is not surprising that you have an interest in astrology, ESP, and reincarnation, and, that you seek the company of individuals and groups who are in tune with the occult. Beware of Utopian tendencies, however, and seek only the positive in psychic powers.

INTERPRETATION, PERSONALITY PROFILE

Getting together all the information that makes up the face of your chart has primarily been mathematical and scientific--in a word, technical. The computer has used the date, time, and place of your birth to select and print out the interpretations of your Sun-sign, your Rising Sign (Ascendant), the Signs on the Houses, the Signs and Houses the Planets are in, and the aspects of the Planets to each other. These interpretations apply only to YOU.

In interpreting the total Personality Profile, however, we must add two more dimensions to the technical: "Symbolism" and "Intuition". These operate mainly from our subconscious mind. Allow your intuition full play as you carefully study the face of the chart and allow its symbolism to "speak" to you. Often the chart can provide a key which opens the subconscious. If you don't consciously "feel" anything, don't worry about it. Just allow the full power of your intuition to apply, and keep your mind as open as you possibly can.

Now go back and read the printouts again: all the way from the Sun-sign through the aspects of Pluto. Try not to reject any statement--not those you dislike, or even those you like. Note any statement which you strongly agree or disagree with, and mark it for later study. Then add all statements which seem to contradict each other to the list. When you study the "contradictive" statements, try to determine if any of them might apply to you at a different time, or in a different place. Then consider if the pair could modify each other and produce an interpretation that does apply to you.

Astrology is not judgmental--it just IS. It doesn't tell us what is "good" or "bad", it only tells us what the influences are. We give the most optimistic and positive interpretation to that information that we possibly can. However, it has been our experience that often the most valuable information we can get from a chart is the awareness of those obstacles and stresses we need to overcome in order to grow and fulfill our lives according to our own individual value systems.
